Adnex 1

Places for training dogs

Dogs are trained at dog schools. The programs offered there help dogs socialize, which is essential for raising well-behaved and well-balanced pets.

Dogschool involves training and playful learning. Owners get to know their dog's abilities, instincts, character, and temperament. In addition to preventing behavioral problems, the programs help puppies get used to different stimuli, other dogs, and people, which reduces their anxiety.

At dog school, dogs learn basic obedience commands (such as "Sit!", "Lie down!", "Heel!", "Stay!", "Come!"), which increases their controllability. They get to know other dogs of the same breed, and their communication with and conflict management skills towards other dogs improve. Playful learning also tires dogs out mentally. During this learning process, owners also learn to handle and understand their dogs, which strengthens the owner-dog relationship.

These programs therefore not only help dogs develop, but also provide valuable social
