ADNEX 1.

The classification of dogs

Working dogs and assistance dogs all perform different tasks, but they all play an important role in human life. These dogs perform various tasks, which are usually aimed at serving their owners or the community.

Working dogs:

- herding and driving dogs
- hunting dogs
- police dogs, e.g. drug detection dogs, guard dogs,
- sled dogs
- rescue dogs, e.g. mountain rescue dogs, search and rescue dogs,

Assistance dogs: These dogs assist humans in certain activities. Examples include

guide dogs,

alarm dogs,

mobility dogs,

hearing dogs,

and dogs that assist people with autism.

These dogs also undergo special training to help their owners with everyday activities such as transportation, picking up objects, or handling emergencies.

Institutional assistance dogs serve to improve people's emotional well-being. They usually work in schools, hospitals, or nursing homes. The presence of dogs helps reduce stress, improves mood, and promotes healing and development. These dogs work under the guidance of a handler.
