1. Annex Description of Games

2, Motivation/ tuning in Group 1 PACSI	Pupils "say hello" to the dog: the pupil stands in front of the dog, asks for a high five and gives the dog a reward treat.
2, 2nd group WORD CLOUD CREATION	<p><u><i>"What do you think of when you think of a dog helping a human? collect the words and expressions that come to mind."</i></u></p> <p>Wordart https://wordart.com/create click on the link to enter the Wordart program. Create a word cloud by typing and formatting the words that come up in response to the question above</p>
3, Sensitisation GUIDE DOG GAME	Pupils form pairs, with the pairs scattered around the room. Each pair is given a blindfold, with which one of them blindfolds themselves and holds onto their partner's arm. The sighted partner's task is to lead the blindfolded partner to one of the dogs, one step at a time, guided by words, stopping him next to the dog. The non-sighted pupil then crouches down, finds the dog with his hands and pets it. With a handkerchief over his eyes, he tries to tell which dog and which part of its body he has found.

<p>5, Teamwork - definition HORIZONTAL PUSH</p>	<p>The concept assistance dogs with disabilities definition available in the PPT "Use of assistance dogs") <u>Preparation</u>: make a puzzle from your text on A3 cardboard beforehand. <u>Classroom game</u>: the class is divided into two groups. The groups are divided into two groups. Unlock the puzzle, read out. We check the text from the PPT "Use of assistance dogs" Reward for the teams that complete the task: the game of the Tunnel</p>
<p>6, Group work - after definition DOWNLOAD - GAME</p>	<p>The members of the puzzle group stand one behind the other in a spread-out position, and the dog runs through the tunnel.</p>
<p>7, Assistance dogs on duty</p>	<p>Observational aspects before screening a short film: https://kutyavalegymosolyert.hu/alapitvany/service-dog-training/ <i>What activities did Bambi help his owner with?</i> <i>What problems does the owner of the assistance dog have that they need help with?</i> <i>How did Bambi know which task to complete?</i> After watching the film, students who answer correctly can ask the helpers present for a trick</p>
<p>8, Round Table - saying goodbye</p>	<p>Question: <i>What did you learn in today's lesson? Which exercise did you like?</i> - The pupils sit around the dogs, stroke the dog one by one and give a short answer.</p>
